WHY ARE LEGACIES IMPORTANT FOR CHRISTIANS IN SPORT?

We are incredibly grateful for the income we receive through legacies. Any legacy left to Christians in Sport enables us to make a lasting impact on the mission field of sport. An impact which helps Christians to integrate sport and faith as well as giving sportspeople an opportunity to explore the gospel message.

HOW DO LEGACIES WORK?

Legacies can be left in your Will or by way of a declaration to the executors of the Will with instructions as to how and which charity the bequest is to be distributed.

WHY SHOULD I MAKE A WILL?

Making a Will means that you can be sure your wishes will be followed after your death. A Will also gives you the opportunity to continue to provide for the people and causes you care about in your lifetime. Whatever your wishes about the distribution of your estate it is advisable to make a Will (if you haven't already) as it is the only legal guarantee your wishes will be kept.

WHAT IF I ALREADY HAVE A WILL?

It is important to keep your Will up-to-date and review it in light of any birth, death, marriage or divorce in your family. If you ever want to add or amend your will you can usually do so cheaply and easily with a legal document called a codicil.

WHAT ABOUT INHERITANCE TAX?

Your solicitor will be best placed to advise you on inheritance tax and explain to you the new rules surrounding tax relief for those who leave 10 percent of their estate to charity. In most cases, your legacy gift to Christians in Sport would be exempt from inheritance tax.

SHOULD I TELL CHRISTIANS IN SPORT I'VE INCLUDED THEM IN MY WILL?

It is entirely up to you what you want to tell us. If you would like to let us know, we'd love to hear from you! Hearing from our supporters about what has inspired you or your loved ones to include Christians in Sport in their Wills is a great inspiration and encouragement for us.

WHAT DO I DO NEXT?

Firstly, if you are considering writing or amending your will seek independent legal advice. A solicitor will be able to walk you through the process. They will ensure that legal formalities are followed and that you feel comfortable about the content of your Will. You can find a local solicitor through the Law Society at www.lawsociety.org.uk.

A solicitor will be able to give you the correct wording to include to leave a legacy in your Will. They will also be able to help add a codicil (an amendment) to your Will if you already have one.
